

Quranic Linguistics for Elementary/Middle School Arabic

As the name suggests, **Easy Introduction to Arabic** (QL Basic) is the easiest level. It is so easy that it even children as young as eight years of age can master it. The recommended frequency is a minimum of two periods per week. For reading comprehension and conversational skills, add two more periods of instruction per week utilizing a curriculum such as العربية للناشئين.

While the following table lists only one possible curriculum layout, it is entirely up to the teacher to decide when to start and determine the pace and frequency.

Suggested Arabic Curriculum Plan for Elementary/Middle Schools

Grade	QL Level	Duration	Frequency (periods/week)
3 rd	QL Basic – Part One	Year-long	2
4 th	QL Basic – Part Two	Year-long	2
5 th	QL1-A	Year-long	2
6 th	QL1-B	Year-long	2
7 th	QL2 (Unit 1)	Year-long	2
8 th	QL2 (Unit 2)	Year-long	2
